More than 2.5 million Coloradans, **44% of the state**, live in a jurisdiction with the newest and most efficient energy code—the 2018 IECC. About 44 jurisdictions have adopted it so far, with another 21 in the process or under consideration.

Nearly 4.9 million Coloradans, **84% of the state**, live in a jurisdiction with a high-efficiency energy code—the 2018, 2015, or 2012 IECC. About 134 jurisdictions are on one of these three editions of the code.
